

Well they finally arrived.



Water Butts

Well if like me you've got at least one water butt I suspect you've been grateful for it during this dry weather. OK, it's not going to be enough to water your plot for weeks on end but I've not had to wait for water troughs to refill when there are lots of people on site watering.

The National Allotment Society has a leaflet about water use on allotments https://www.nsalg.org.uk/wp-content/uploads/2012/09/A5_Water_260213_HiRes.pdf that provides a method for estimating how much rain you can collect.

The average annual rainfall for the Woburn weather station, available on the Met Office website, is 652mm. For a standard 6ft by 4ft (24 sq ft or 2.2 sq m) shed you can collect 1145 litres (2.2 sq m x 622 x 0.8 assuming 80% efficiency) .

I might need more water butts!
