

#### **Liability Insurance**


Part of your LLAA membership fee is used to provide members with public liability insurance, but have you and your family/friends got the cover you need?

Please refer to the insurance documents on our website. In summary: -

- Each LLAA member is covered by the policy arranged, this applies to both Full and Associate Members.
- Family and friends who are not LLAA members are also covered while
  working on the member's plot <u>BUT ONLY</u> if the LLAA member is present
  at the time of incident.
- If family or friends are working on a member's plot without the member present then family and friends are <u>NOT</u> covered.

Therefore if, as a LLAA member, you have family or friends who are not LLAA members that attend your plot without you being present you may wish to consider them joining the LLAA as an Associate Member. The current Associate member annual fee is £3.00.
